Commercial Fertilizers.

SUCCESSFUL FARMING MORE AND MORE
DEPENDENT UPON THEIR ECONOMIC
AND INTELLIGENT USE—WORK FOR
EXPERIMENT STATIONS.

For some years I have given the matter of commercial fertilizers and fertilization considerable attention, and am inclined to the belief that their economical and intelligent use is destined to play a very important part in the future of the raising of crops in this country. It was hardly prepared for the statement which I received from a fertilizer agent recently that he had just sold a farmer (not in this county) \$1,100 worth of fertilizer for his own use next season. If this is an indication of what other farmers may do, it shows that the bumper crops and the prevailing high prices and quick sales have had their effect, and that farming, in Maine, at least, is to be considerably extended in the season of 1909.

With these prospects before us, the best methods of procedure, both in purchasing and in using these fertilizers of great importance. In relation to the purchasing, it appears that the first improvement should be cash always as possible. Goods bought for cash always come the cheapest. In this connection I believe it will pay farmers to unite and secure money, and then buy their goods. But just here comes a difficulty. In many neighborhoods one farmer will have nothing except a few chickens or a few cows, and another farmer will have nothing except a few chickens or a few cows. As a consequence, the goods are bought in small lots and through different agents at a maximum of cost for every transaction. All this should be remedied through the elimination of the middle man, and the centering of the analysis. The analysis tests the value of the goods, and the value, and, in a sense, a trick of the trade. High grade goods quickly available are, on general principles, the best for the farmer. If you wish to grow very rapidly the latter part of the season, grain and grass will handle more slowly available goods to advantage. The proportion of actual fertilizing material should be equally high. Outside of the advent of the cash system of buying and the uniting on one grade of goods as far as possible, the uniting of more importance than the adaptation of the goods to the needs of the soil. The Winter Egg Question.

THE FARMER MAY HAVE ROSES WHEN THEY ARE HIGHEST IF HE WILL MANAGE RIGHT.

Fresh eggs continue high and scarce. Prices are above the average for this time of the year. Eggs are a summer product, but by preference are a winter product, and consumers are using them in spite of high prices.

The winter egg question is getting to be quite interesting because we can see hard cash in it. There are several reasons why the farmer should give this problem careful consideration. In the first place, the average farmer is best situated to make the most from the winter egg business. The foods valuable for winter egg production are produced on the farm. The average farmer has more time now than at any other season to care for the hens. On most farms there is little being made from dairy and other farm products at this season; this is another good reason why the farmer should make an effort to secure at least a fair winter egg yield.
