Tuesday of September, Anno Domini 1820.

State vs Lewis Boyinton: Forgery: And now in this term the said Lewis
Boyinton is set to the bar, and has this Indictment read to him, and for plea says that
thereof he is guilty: It is therefore considered by the Court here, that the said Lewis
Boyinton be punished by solitary imprisonment for the term of twelve days, and that
afterwards he be confined to hard labor for the term of two years, and that this sentence
be executed upon him in and within the precinct of the common Jail, situated in
Morridgewock, in the County of Somerset, and that he stand committed until he be
removed to said Jail, in execution of this sentence.
