MAINE COMMANDERY OF THE LOYAL LEGION TO ERECT MEMORIAL TO HANNAH LINCOLN.

PARIS HILL WITH IMPRESSIVE CEREMONIES ON THE CENTENNIAL ANNIVERSARY OF HIS BIRTH.

The State of Maine, with its long list of able statesmen who have given it a power and influence in shaping national legislation far beyond its relative importance, has never had a president and only one vice-president of the United States. As the game politics is played in these modern times, it is probable that it may never have another. In view of the great importance upon the nation's history of the times through which he served as well as the ability and fidelity with which he upheld the policies and principles of the great emancipator, what could be more fitting than a proper memorial to the services of Hannah Lincoln upon the one hundredth anniversary of his birth and upon the historic spot where he was born?

The Maine Commandery of the Military Order of the Loyal Legion of the United States have recognized the fitness of the subject, the time and the place, and have made preparations for the erection and dedication of such a memorial at the birthplace of the statesman in the historic little village of Paris Hill on the twenty-seventh day of August next.
