CLERK'S RETURN OF VOTES

ON PROPOSED PRIVATE AND SPECIAL ACT

Given in at the Special Election, September 14th, 1931

At legal meetings of the inhabitants of the City of Lewiston in the County of Androscoggin, qualified by the Constitution to vote, duly called and legally held in the various voting precincts of said city, on the second Monday in September, the same being the fourteenth day of said month in the year of our Lord, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-one, the said inhabitants gave in their votes upon the Proposed Private and Special Act proposed by an Act of the Eighty-fifth Legislature. The said votes were received, sorted, counted and declared in open ward meetings by the respective wardens who presided and in the presence of the respective ward clerks, who made records thereof in the presence of the warden and in open ward meetings sealed up the copies of said records, duly attested by the several wardens and ward clerks, and returned to the city clerk of said city on the Fourteenth day of September, the same being within twenty-four hours after said meetings. The aldermen of said city were in session within twenty-four hours after the close of the polls and at said meeting, in the presence of the city clerk, opened and examined the returns from the respective wards of which the said clerk made a record as follows, to wit:
