Winter Eggs.

FOR WHICH BIRDS MUST BE WELL-FED,
BUT NOT OVERFED.

In the feeding of a large number of
fowl, the dry mash which has been
steadily gaining favor for the past few
years, certainly has advantages over wet
mash feeding, two of which are the sav-
ing of labor in making mash, and that
the dry system allows more variation in
the time of feeding, and the mash feeding,
however, will continue to be used to ad-
vantage in many places. "Wet mash
feeding has its place and a great deal of
the refuse material at home on the farm
can be worked into a wet mash much
more successfully than it can into a dry
mash. For instance, such material as
corn, bran, middlings, etc., into a very
palatable mash."

"The best of forcing hens for eggs
in the winter time is in the proper use of
the protein foods," writes Prof. Brown
of U. of M. "The egg itself is a highly
concentrated product and rich in fat,
