The Standing Committee on Warrants,

Report

That, by a Resolve, on the Pay Roll of the Senate, of the eleventh day of February current, there is directed to be paid out of the Treasury, to the several persons named in said Roll, the sums set against their names respectively - amounting in the whole to two thousand five hundred and twenty one dollars - including the pay of the Secretary, Assistant, Messengers and Doorkeeper -

The Committee therefore recommend that the Governor be advised to draw his warrant on the Treasury for the said sum of two thousand five hundred and twenty one dollars, which is the amount of said Pay Roll, including the officers and attendants aforesaid.
