W. C. T. U. County Convention.

The twenty-fourth annual convention of the Oxford County W. C. T. U. opened in the Universalist church at Bethel Tuesday morning.

The program was opened by a devotion service led by Mrs. Nellie L. Curtis. At 11 o'clock the president, Mrs. George H. Kimball, presided.

A warm welcome was extended to the delegates by the local president, Mrs. O. M. Mason, to which Mrs. Ella M. Bates of West Paris most appropriately responded.

Reports of the corresponding secretary and treasurer were given after the appointment of the usual committees.

The reports showed the financial affairs to be in a prosperous condition, and the reports from the Unions showed good work done during the year.

Adjournment was taken for three months in June.

The most interesting feature of the afternoon session was the president's message, which in part outlined a plan for the year and urged every member to do her share during this campaign; and urged also the holding of many public meetings in the rural districts, and suggested that the motto be, "We work to win."

At 3:30 about one hundred and thirty school children marched in under the leadership of their teachers from the "Bible building," and under their direction, assisted by Mrs. Banghart, gave a most interesting program of music and song. The program was given by the children and the other by Marion Frost. The selections were from the Protestant Reformation, and the songs were sung with enthusiasm by the children as a real expression of their hearts.

After the program, Mrs. Banghart spoke to the children and held their closest attention.

The evening address was given by Mrs. L. M. Stevens, who filled the place left vacant by Mrs. Seberry's being called home. She was able and earnest, and called to the attention of the audience the importance of the campaign for the year, and the need of unwearability in the work.
