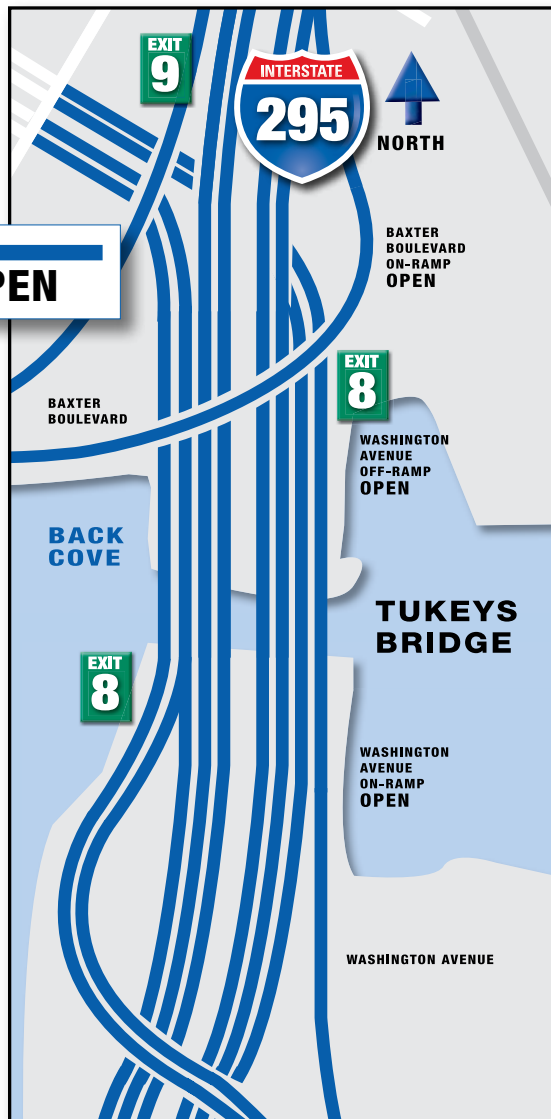
BIG SURPRISE FOR MOTORISTS ON TUKEYS BRIDGE.

Drivers should be extra cautious when crossing Portland's Tukeys Bridge over the coming days. MaineDOT advises motorists to remain calm and focused when they discover that the bridge has four fully open travel lanes, both northbound and southbound, and all previously closed exits will be reopened sometime this week.

- Baxter Blvd On-Ramp Open
