The Seed Problem in Potato Planting.
In a November issue of the Tribune Farmer I called attention to the failure of a lot of potatoes to start in 1910 when planted alongside of another lot of the same variety, grown upon the same piece of land, the only difference being that one lot had been stored in a potato house, the other in a house cellar. The former were hard, heavy as when dug and not an eye had started; the latter showed swollen eyes and sprouts just opening at the time of planting. As another series of letters has been received from growers in different states have reported similar trouble; others have written confirming the solution stated. As another series of letters is approaching, it may be of some service to suggest that it will be well to take the seed from the cellar, and store from the colder storeroom, and spread on the ground for a few days to warm up and for the buds to swell before planting.
