Report

That by a Resolue of the Legislature passed the 24th of February instant, there is directed to be paid out of the Treasury of this State to Moses Davis for services of Messenger, door keeper and page to the House of Representatives, four dollars & fifty cents, for each & every day he has been there employed during the present Session of the Legislature. The Committee find that the said Moses Davis has been employed as mentioned in said Resolue fifty days - and that he is entitled for his services to the sum of two hundred & twenty five dollars. - They therefore recommend, that the Governour be advised to draw his Warrant on the Treasurer in favor of the said Davis, for the said sum of two hundred and twenty five dollars.
