As to the balance due me for services, as a Bank Commissioner, last year. —

I would state that my whole Bill including time and expenses was \$ 418.92. — The Committee of Council allowed me only 366.42 — I was therefore wronged, as the whole Bill was justly due me, for it is to be remembered, 1. That I examined all the Banks & made my Report, without any assistance, having had no colleague with me during the whole examination. — 2 The Report was a very full & extended one, covering 69 or 70 pages, when printed. It had been a critical time for Banks, & I thought they ought to have been fully examined & reported. — 3 I examined the Old Town Bank, in very particular & reported a detail of facts — a work of 10 days at least. — 4 Perceiving the defects in the Statutes on Banking, especially, when a Bank like that had failed, I drew & transmitted a Bill, which contained provisions exceedingly needed. — 5 I kept an account of every day's labor with the utmost care, while visiting the Banks & making a Report. I know the days charged were no more than the days employed. — 6. I did not charge for Sabbaths, tho I believe they are not deducted from a Legislator's pay. — 7 My whole charge, after all was comparatively small, — never before cost the Govt. so little by a large sum.
