The money disbursed is over six thousand dollars, and the compensation, at five per cent commission, which was formerly allowed for disbursements, would amount to more than three hundred dollars. I charge two days for my time and responsibility, in giving instructions, examining the accounts, and paying the bills, on each of the appropriations for gun houses. There has been in addition, considerable business in relation to these expenditures and in the ordinary business of the Quartermaster's department, for which I have made no charge against the State.
