The Standing Committee on Warrants Report; That the Governor be advised to draw his Warrant on the Treasurer of State, in favor of John Francis and Scattis Neptune, for twentyfive dollars each, agreeably to a Resolve of the Legislature approved Feb 17. 1841; Also, in favor of Henry Richardson, Agent for Pindob-set Indians, for the sum of three hundred and fiftyseven dollars and ninety cents, for Agricultural improvements, agreeably to a Resolve of the Legislature approved March 5. 1841; to be charged to and paid out of the appropriation made for said purposes, under the act of April 17. 1841.
