This witness that Elijah Kellogg superintendent of the
Indian school delivered in my presence to Delia
Molly wife of Salmore two dollars for their
sick son (who has been disabled for about two
years and seems near death) as part of the
donation, made by the Government to the poor &
sick of this tribe —

Pier Socka two dollars — who is thought
to be in a consumption as part of the grant
