The Committee of Council to whom was referred the communication respecting the expenses of removing the ordnance and military stores belonging to this State from Boston to Portland, Report, That, as the Legislature have made no specific appropriation to defray these expenses, it is expedient that an additional advance be made out of the Contingent fund. They, therefore, recommend that the Governor be advised to draw his Warrant on the Treasury of this State, in favor of Albion K Parry for the sum of fifty dollars, for the purposes aforesaid, and to be charged to said appropriation, for the expenditure of which he is to be accountable. —
