An Act Allowing the Town of Pittsfield to Obtain Water from the Town of Burnham. (Approved for introduction by a majority of the Legislative Council pursuant to Joint Rule 27.) Presented by Senator CIANCHETTE of Somerset; Cosponsored by Senators: GOULD of Waldo, MARDEN of Kennebec, Representatives: CLEMENT of Clinton, TOWNSEND of Canaan. Referred to Joint Standing Committee on Utilities. No Public Hearing. Final Disposition: Indefinitely Postponed 05/25/93.
