In Council, February 8. 1823.

The Standing Committee on Warrants,  
Report.

That, by a Resolue of the Legislature of the fifth day of February instant, there is allowed and directed to be paid out of the Treasury of the State to Daniel Rose the sum of one hundred and fifteen dollars; to Benjamin Greene the sum of one hundred and twenty five dollars; and, to John Chandler the sum of seventy dollars, in full for their services and expenses as a Committee appointed by the Governor and Council, agreeably to a Resolue of the last Legislature, to collect information and investigate the subject of the punishment of convicts, and the establishment of a State Prison or Penitentiary, and also the subject of the location of the seat of Government. The Committee, therefore, recommend that the Governor be advised to draw his <sup>several</sup> warrants, ~~is~~ on the Treasury of this State, in favor of Daniel Rose, for the said sum of one hundred and fifteen dollars; of Benjamin Greene for the <sup>said</sup> sum of one hundred and twenty five dollars; and, of John Chandler for the <sup>said</sup> sum of seventy dollars.
