In Council, November 20. 1824

The Committee of Council, to whom was referred the doings of the Committee appointed, under the Resolue of the Legislature of the eighteenth day of February 1824, to locate a road from township number four, in the second range, north of the Bingham purchase, to meet a road which is laid out from the plantation of Boulton to the Baskahygon River, Report: That the said Committee have performed the services required of them, by their appointment, and have made a full and detailed Report of their doings, which is herewith submitted; and that, in performing these services, the said Committee have exceeded the appropriation of six hundred dollars, made by the Legislature of this State, under the Resolue aforesaid, by the sum of nineteen dollars and eighty eight cents, for which the said Committee have produced satisfactory vouchers: — The Committee further Report, that four hundred dollars, part of the appropriation aforesaid has been drawn from the Treasury, leaving a balance of two hundred dollars remaining yet to be drawn: They therefore recommend that the Governor be advised to draw his Warrant on the Treasury, in favor of Daniel Wilkins, Esq, Chairman of said Committee, for the said sum of two hundred dollars, being the balance of the appropriation aforesaid.
