Do you know that this country now leads not only in the mining of radium, but also in the scientific exploitation and practical application of it?

Since the discovery of radium, let us see that no energy is wasted upon it. A good-sized tray will serve to convey all the radium that is needed for the day. All the better if there is a "kitchen wagon." It is desirable to have enough tableware to serve twice, to avoid the necessity of washing it more than once.
