STATE OF MAINE.

In Council, *Sept. 24.* 1841.

The standing Committee on **COUNTY TREASURERS' ACCOUNTS**, to which was referred the account of *Charles P. Chandler* treasurer of the County of *Piscataquis*, having carefully examined the same, **REPORT:**

That they find the same well vouched and correctly cast, and there is a balance due from the State to said treasurer, of *Sixty two dollars*  $\frac{43}{100}$

The Committee therefore recommend, That the Governor be advised to draw his warrant on the Treasurer of State in favor of *Charles P. Chandler* treasurer as aforesaid, for the sum of *Sixty two dollars*  $\frac{43}{100}$  which will be in full for the balance of his account to the *eighths* day of *July* A. D. 1841.
