The Standing Committee on Military affairs, to whom was referred the petition of Abraham Longly and others, soldiers in the town of Dover in the fifth Regiment, first Brigade and third Division, representing that they are organized into a Company with the town of Foxcroft, which makes it inconvenient for them to do duty, as they are obliged to go out of the limits of their own town; and further representing there are more than soldiers enough in each of said towns to make a full company, and praying to be set off as a company, the limits of which to contain said town of Dover, having had the same under consideration, ask leave to Report:— that the said petition is approved by the commanding officer of said company; by the Colonel, Brigadier and Major Generals of said Regiment, Brigade and Division; and that, for the reasons set forth in said petition, it is the opinion of the Committee that the prayer of the petition ought to be granted, and a new company organized in said town of Dover, and annexed to said Regiment. And ^{that} the Governor and Commander in Chief be advised to cause an order to be issued organizing and attaching said new company accordingly. —
