The Standing Committee on County Treasurers accounts, to whom was referred the account of Henry Smith, Esq. Treasurer of the County of York, having carefully examined the same, Report; That the said account is well vouched, and correctly cast, and that there is a balance due from the State to the said Smith of four hundred forty two dollars and thirty seven cents. The Committee, therefore recommends that the Governor be advised to draw his warrant on the Treasury of this State in favor of the said Smith Treasurer as aforesaid, for the said sum of four hundred forty two dollars and thirty seven cents, which will be in full for the balance of his account up to the twelfth day of January instant.
