Please join the Maine Department of Transportation (MaineDOT) on Thursday, February 25, 2010, at an informational and scoping public meeting to discuss the future replacement of the Martin Memorial Bridge (#3248), currently located on Route 232, 0.1 mile south of U.S. Route 2 over the Androscoggin River. MaineDOT is currently investigating several alignment options for the bridge replacement, including on or adjacent to the existing alignment, upstream from the existing alignment, and downstream of the existing alignment. The various conceptual alignment options, including benefits and potential impacts, will be presented at the meeting.

Representatives of MaineDOT will be present on Thursday evening, February 25, 2010, at 6:00 p.m. to listen to concerns, receive comments, and answer questions from anyone with an interest in the project. MaineDOT is particularly interested in learning local views relative to project consistency with local comprehensive plans, discovering local resources, and identifying local concerns and issues. Anyone with an interest is invited to attend and participate in the meeting.

Accommodations will be made for persons with disabilities. Auxiliary aids will be provided upon advance request.
