The Court having examined the above account of Joseph H. Hill Keeper of the State Gaol in Norridgewood, on oath exhibited, do find that the charges for the support of prisoners confined upon charges and convictions of crimes against the State by due process of Law, who were unable to support themselves, from the 14th day of March 1841 to the 6th day of October 1841 inclusive amounts to Ninety two dollars & seventy cents, and that said prisoners have not been able to pay any part thereof. It is therefore Ordered by the Court here, that the same be allowed and paid out of the Treasury of this County, and charged to the State agreeable to the provisions of Law.
