Please join us at 6:00pm on Thursday, March 19, 2009, at a preliminary public meeting to discuss the future removal of the Charles River Bridge (#2151). The bridge is located 2.6 miles westerly of the junction of Route 5 on Harbor Road.

Representatives of the Maine Department of Transportation will be present at 6:00pm to listen to concerns, receive comments, and answer questions from anyone with an interest in the project. The Department will be discussing the potential closure of the Charles River Bridge as it relates to traffic movements in the area. The Red Iron Bridge on McNeil Road will be looked at during the investigation of the Charles River Bridge to determine if one is redundant and lends itself to future cost savings via removal.

Anyone with an interest is invited to attend and participate in the meeting.

Accommodations will be made for persons with disabilities. Auxiliary aids will be provided upon advance request.
