from Boston to Portland. by virtue of a requisition
from the Executive of Maine to that of Massachusetts
in October 1841—

viz- to expenses, time, &c getting a requisition from the
Executive of Maine ————— 3,00

viz- { Expenses - going to Boston after Sargeant -
 { Steam Boat fare 4,00 - expenses in Boston 3,00 --- 7,00
 { Hack Hire 50 - three days time \$10,00 10,50

The requisition not being sufficiently particular to suit the
Boston folks a second was necessary—

" Expenses - time &c in getting second requisition 3,00

Do - going to Boston second time after Sargeant
viz Steam Boat fare 4,00 Expenses in Boston 3,50 --- 7,50
Hack Hire --- 50

paid for Sargeant. Steamboat fare. Supper & hack hire 2,75

to time & expenses in going to Boston
in company with a Barrell of Cloathing which
was left (by some person unknown) at the
Steamboat Storehouse, marked - Boston, & which
were the property stolen from Mr Wm M. Garrison's store
I went to Boston in the same Boat, in order to
arrest whoever should call for it, in Boston,
but owing to some difficulty which Sargeant got into
the day we arrived there he did not call for the goods
until the next day, when he called at the Storehouse
in Boston for the Barrell of goods where I had left them,
when he was arrested by Mr Clapp whom I had
employed for that purpose -

Steamboat fare --- 4,00

Expenses in Boston --- 2,75

three days time --- 10,00

16,75

as this Bill was incurred ^{a few days} previous to the procuring
of the requisition, with the hope of arresting Sargeant
at the time, and bringing him directly back in the boat -
and I am unable to lose it - I respectfully submit
to the Honorable the Governor & the Council this bill
hoping they will see fit to allow it - S. O. Danielson
