As per your request in your letter dated your case is being referred to the State Claims Commission for inclusion on their docket of cases for upcoming hearings.

Scheduling for hearings is the responsibility of the State Claims Commission. Typically, hearings are not scheduled until construction of the highway project is complete. Maine Law (23 M.R.S.A. Sec. 156) requires notice of hearings be mailed to owners at least 14 days before the date of hearing.

The Department of Transportation representatives will continue to work with you in an effort to reach settlement without the need for a hearing.
