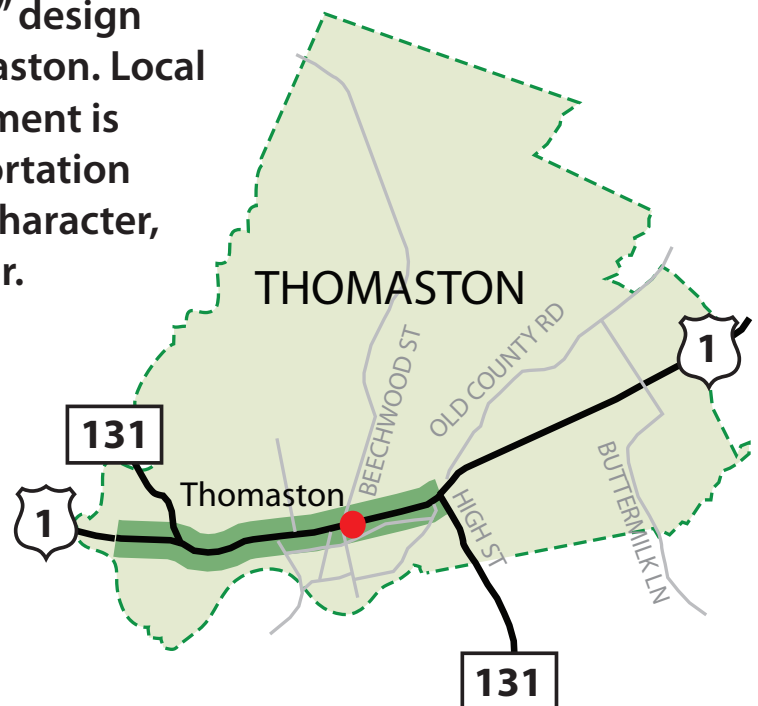
WHEN: Wednesday, January 26th, 6:00pm to 8:00 pm
