In Council January 3^d 1842

The Standing Committee on Warrents, to which was referred the account of Richard Libbey, Agent for repairing ^{the} Military road, agreeably to a Resolue approved April 16th 1841, having carefully examined said account, and the vouchers accompanying the same, Report; That the several items of charge against the State amount to the sum of twenty five hundred sixteen dollars & thirty eight cents, all of which charges appear to be well vouch'd;

Said Libbey has charged the sum of thirty dollars, for going to Bangor several times after money in payment of his said account; The Committee being of opinion that said charge is too high, have allowed him the sum of thirteen dollars & sixty two cents, in full of the above named charge for going to Bangor, which reduces the amount of the whole account against the State, to the sum of twenty five hundred dollars;

Said Libbey charges himself with the sum of twenty five hundred dollars received from the State, though the hands of Elijah L. Hamlin, Land Agent, at ^{on account of the Treasurer of State by authority of Warrants Nos. 5353 & 5354} many times, which balances his said account for expenditures in the Military road aforesaid.
