Plan Ahead for Flaggy Meadow Road Closure!



Due to Gorham Bypass construction activity, Flaggy Meadow Road will be closed to through traffic from the Webster/Waterman intersection to Cressey Road. Only local traffic will be allowed to travel between those two roads. The Flaggy Meadow Road closure begins Monday, September 24th and is expected to last for 4 weeks depending on weather and other circumstances. We know this is inconvenient and urge motorists to allow plenty of extra time and drive with caution. Detour signs will be visible and we ask motorists to drive courteously through these alternate routes.
