# PREPARING FOR THE CLOSING OF I-295 NORTHBOUND

## PAVING THE WAY FOR A SAFER DRIVE

You may have already noticed we are getting ready for the rehabilitation of I-295 Northbound from Topsham to Gardiner. If you travel between Brunswick and Gardiner, portions of lanes will be closed for bridge and culvert repairs, as well as paving, from now until the closure on June 15th.

Continuing through August, northbound traffic will be routed on the newly rehabilitated southbound lanes and southbound drivers can take Route 201 or the Turnpike.
