

At a meeting of the Commissioners appointed
under the act of separation at the State House in
the City of Boston July 22nd 1825

Ordered, that the sum of Fifteen Hundred dollars
be appropriated as necessary to defray the expenses of
the surveys directed to be made the present season, &
that the Executives of the two States be requested to
draw warrants in favor of Reuel Williams & Daniel
Rose Esquires respectively for the one half of said sum
each, they to be accountable to the Board for the
just expenditure thereof.
