A DELICATE SALAD.
Cut cold boiled Irish potatoes in small, thin, disc-shaped particles. Mix a large mayonaisse sauce of vinegar boiled with the beaten yolk of an egg, salt, sugar, olive oil and mustard. Set the mayonaisse to one side to cool while rich, thick cream is beaten to a fine froth. Stir the mayonaisse with cold black pepper. Pour the mayonaisse and pour it all over the chopped potatoes, and gently mix the whole with a salad spoon. One pint of cream will make over a quart after it is whipped three times as much as much whipped cream as there is of the mayonaisse. This salad differs from other kinds in being less compact and more creamy.
