In Council Oct^r 13. 1825.

The Committee of Council to whom was referred the account of Elliott Vaughan, Clerk employed in the Office of the Secretary of State, in Copying the Acts and proceedings of the Legislature and of the Governor and Council Reported:

That by a Resolve of the Legislature, passed the twenty-sixth day of February last, the sum of six hundred and eighty dollars is appropriated for the purpose of paying the Clerks employed as aforesaid; Provided the accounts of said Clerks be first examined and allowed by the Governor and Council; five hundred and ninety two dollars and fifty cents of which have been drawn from the Treasury; leaving a balance unapplied of ~~Eighty~~ seven dollars and fifty cents; that they have examined the account of the said Vaughan, and find the charges therein contained are for services performed since the twenty fourth day of June last, up to which time he has heretofore been paid; and that the same are made conformable to the provisions of said Resolve, and that there is now due to the said Vaughan the sum of - forty eight - dollars, which will be in full for his services as aforesaid, up to, and including the thirteenth day of October instant. The Committee therefore, recommend that the Governor be advised to draw his Warrant on the Treasury in favor of the said Vaughan accordingly.
