The stock is all fitted and ready for use, and placed in drying rooms, in large supply ready for use at all times.

Every room in this spacious building is fitted as work shop or storage room. Some large rooms are packed with the different parts and pieces which are used to make the whole frame. Thousands of these frames are ready for the time when they are needed, and the time of construction are found here ready to fill any order large or small, which may come in, at a very short notice.
