To expense from Brunswick to Augusta
and back - Aug. 10th to 13th inclusive -

4 days - stage fare 2.50 - packet 3.29 - 5.79

To expense from Brunswick to Bangor,
from there to Belfast and Castine - and
back to Belfast & Bangor, and from there to
Brunswick - stage fare, Steam boat &
expense - including amount paid Capt.

Smart for going to Belfast twice and
Capt. Ellis for going to Castine - amount

of Capt. Leighton's bill - Stationary, postage
&c. - absent from home from Aug.

16th to 28th inclusive - 13 days - 57.85

To time incurred in the foregoing - after
my return from Washington - 17 days, 22^{cts} - 34.00
