Somerset sp. Commissioners' Court March Term A. D. 1842.

The Court having examined the above account of John C. Page Keeper of the State Jail in Norridgewood, on oath exhibited, do find that the charges for the support of prisoners confined upon charges and convictions of crimes against the State, by due process of law, who were unable to support themselves from February 14th to March 17th 1842 inclusive, amount to the sum of Seventeen dollars & sixty eight cents, and that said prisoners have not been able to pay any part thereof. It is therefore ordered by the Court here that the same be allowed and paid out of the Treasury of this County and charged to the State agreeably to the provisions of law.
