In Council, Nov<sup>r</sup> 10<sup>th</sup> 1842.

The Standing Committee on Military Affairs to which was referred the petition of Ernek Fogg and others of the B. Company of Cavalry in the first Brigade and fifth Division, praying that said Company may be disbanded, having duly considered the same Report: That said petition is approved by the commanding officers of said Brigade and Division, and the Committee are of opinion said Company should be disbanded.

They therefore recommend that the Governor and Commander-in-Chief be advised to cause an order to be issued whereby said Company shall be disbanded and the members thereof liable to the performance of military duty enrolled in the standing companies within whose limits they severally reside.
