And now at this term of the Court on examining the foregoing account of Thomas Crocker underkeeper of the States Jail in Paris in the County of Oxford on oath exhibited do find, that the Charges for support of Prisoners in said Jail unable to support themselves, committed by due process of law upon charges or conviction of crimes against the State, & therein confined, from the sixteenth day of June to the twenty sixth day of October A.D. 1830 amount to the sum of Eighty two dollars & sixty five cents & that said Prisoners have not been able to pay any part thereof: therefore, said sum has been allowed & ordered by the Court to be paid out of the Treasury of this County, & charged to the State agreeably to the Statute in such case made & provided.
