For my services and expenses incurred in seizing  
driving & securing timber cut by trespassers on the  
States land on the waters of the Dead river - in the  
Spring of the year 1829

Viz To my time & expenses one day going  
to Augusta to receive the directions and  
instructions of the Land Agent \$3.00

For my time to Dead river to seize & secure logs  
cut by trespassers on the States land 13 days at 18¢ per day 39.00  
Amount paid for expenses and for horse and sleigh \$5.50

Paid to Jacob Gardner for his going with me to  
Dead River and assisting in seizing lumber on the  
States land 35.00

Paid to Samuel Clark cutting up & taking  
care of said logs 49.50

Paid Paul Stevens for going to Bingham to  
find the alteration of Marks on the logs 10.00

Paid for men and expenses for driving said logs 40.00

Paid to Jacob Gardner for his assistance in setting  
& making up report to the Land Agent 2 days &  
6.00

Journey to Augusta 230.00
