And now the Court, on examination of ~~the~~^{within} account, do find the charges for support of prisoners in gaol, unable to support themselves, confined by due process of law, on charge or conviction of crimes or offences against the State, from the said 13th day of October 1830, to the said 11th day of January 1831 inclusive amount to the sum of one hundred & nineteen dollars & fifteen cents, & that said prisoners have not been able to pay any part thereof. Whereupon it is ordered that the same be allowed & paid out of the County Treasury & charged to the State, agreeable to the Statute in such case provided.
