Diamond of Bangor; Co-sponsored by Sen. Perkins of Hancock. State & Local Government Hearing 09/16/88. OTP Accepted 09/16/88. Finally Passed, CON RES LAWS, Chapter 4. Approved in Referendum, 11/06/88 (In favor: 292,335; Opposed: 232,456).
