The Court on examining the within account of Jason Hinds keeper of the State Gaol in the county of Somerset on oath exhibited do find the charges for the support of prisoners unable to support themselves, committed by due process of law upon charges or convictions of crimes against the State from the sixteenth day of March last past to the fourth day of October instant inclusive amounting to forty one Dollars and ninety one cents are regular and correct, and that said prisoners have not been able to pay any part thereof. The same is therefore ordered to be paid out of the Treasury of the county and charged to the State.
