In Council, March, 6th 1843.

The Standing Committee on Military Affairs to which was referred the communication of the Adjutant General stating recommending that the C. company of Infantry in the first Regiment of the first Brigade ^{and 21st Division}, be disbanded, having considered the same, Report: That they are of opinion said company should be disbanded, and recommend that the Governor and Commander in Chief cause an order to be issued, whereby said Company shall be disbanded, and the members thereof liable to the performance of military duty enrolled in the B. company of Infantry of the third Regiment of said Brigade, and ^{the} ~~the~~ limits ~~of said B. company~~ shall be the town lines of Buckfield, hereafter be the limits of the said B-Company.
