Hancock Co. Court of County Commissioners at Castine, April Term, A.D. 1833.

And now in this term Thos. J. Whiting Under Keeper of the State's Jail in Castine within & for said County, exhibits his account under oath, for the support of prisoners in said Jail confined & unable to support themselves, committed by due process of law, upon charge or conviction of crimes or offenses against said State, from the 10th day of October 1832, to the 1st day of May 1833; amounting to the sum of \$40.60; & that said prisoners have not been able to pay any part thereof: Therefore Ordered, that said sum of \$40.60 be allowed and paid out of the Treasury of this County, to said Thos. J. Whiting, and charged to the State, agreeably to the Statute in such case made and provided. Attest Thos. Cobb Clerk.
