Whiting, Under Keeper of the State's Gaol in Castine within & for said County, exhibits his account under oath, for the support of prisoners in said Gaol confined & unable to support themselves, committed by due process of law, upon charge or conviction of crimes or offences against said State, from the 10<sup>th</sup> day of October 1032, to the 1<sup>st</sup> day of May 1033; amounting to the sum of \$40.60; & that said prisoners have not been able to pay any part thereof: Therefore Ordered, that said sum of \$40.60 be allowed and paid out of the Treasury of this County, to said Thos. J. Whiting, and charged to the State, agreeably to the Statute in such case made and provided.
