Kennebec. sp.

At a meeting of the County Commissioners begun and holden at Augusta within and for the County of Kennebec on the first Tuesday of June (being the seventh day of said month) Anno Domini 1831. The County Commissioners on examining the account of Jesse Robinson Esq. Keeper of the States Gaol in Augusta in the County of Kennebec on oath exhibited do find that the charges for the support of prisoners in said Gaol, unable to support themselves committed by due process of Law upon Charge or Conviction of Crimes or offences against the State; and therein confined from the 26th of April to the 7th of June 1831 amounting to the sum of twenty eight dollars and twenty nine cents, and that said prisoners have not been able to pay any part thereof: therefore said sum has been allowed by the County Commissioners and ordered to be paid out of the Treasury of this County, and charged to the State, agreeably to the Statute in such case made and provided.
