State of Maine - Washington Is. At the Court of Sessions begun and holden at Machias within & for the County of Washington on the first Wednesday next after the first Tuesday of March AD 1831  
The Court on examining the foregoing account of John Foster Gaoler, Keeper of the State Gaol in Machias in said County on oath exhibited, do find that the Charges of supporting prisoners in said Gaol, unable to support themselves, committed by due process of law, upon Charge or Conviction of Crime against the State, and therein confined from the Sixteenth day of December 1830 to the third day of March 1831 both inclusive, amount to the sum of Fifty dollars & forty cents that said prisoners have not been able to pay any part thereof; that said sum has been allowed and paid out of the County Treasury of said County; and is by law to be charged to the State
