State of Maine - Washington Co. At a Meeting of the County Commissioners for the County of Washington begun & holden at Machias within said County on the first Wednesday next after the third Tuesday of September & continued by adjournment to the 14th day of December A.D. 1831. The said Commissioners, on examining the foregoing account of John Foster Keeper of the State's Gaol in Machias in said County, on oath exhibited, Do find that the Charges of supporting prisoners in said Gaol, unable to support themselves, committed by due process of law, upon Charge or Conviction of Crimes against the State, and therein confined from the 22nd day of September to the 14th day of December 1831 inclusive. Amount to the sum One hundred & Forty Seven dollars & ninety eight cents - that said prisoners have not been able to pay any part thereof; that said sum has been allowed & paid out of the County Treasury of said County; and is by law to be charged to the State.
