

We the subscribers Land Agents for the State of
Maine and Commonwealth of Massachusetts do there-
by grant permission for and in behalf of said state
and Commonwealth, to William Emerson Esquire, of
Bangor in the County of Penobscot and State of Maine,
aforesaid, Merchant, to cut or cause to be cut, the
timber upon a certain tract of the undivided land
belonging to the two states lying between the East
branch of the Penobscot river and Sebais stream &
North of the line running due west from the
Monument at the source of the St Croix, where the
same was injured the past year by fire; also all
the meadows on the lands belonging to each state,
and on the undivided lands, within the vicinity of
said timber, which may include all the meadows
on the rivers northely and westerly of the mouth of
Mettauencus river, to be used for subsistence of the cattle
employed in drawing said timber, so long as said mead-
ows remain the property of said states.

For which timber the said Emerson is to pay twenty six
cents per thousand to said state of Maine, and twenty six
cents per thousand to said Commonwealth, to be fairly
scaled, or appraised equal to merchantable boards, One
third of the amount when the logs are scaled, one third
in six months, and one third in twelve months therefrom,
with interest.

tendency to embarrass the sale of the land and timber on
a large portion of the public lands and interferes essentially
with the arrangements now making in the operations re-
lative to the same. Therefore in consideration of the sum of
three thousand dollars to me in hand paid by Daniel Rose
and George W Coffin the Land agents of the state of Maine
and Commonwealth of Massachusetts for and in be-
half of said states, I do hereby relinquish to said states
all my right title & interest in and to the same from
this time, henceforth, and for which I have given du-
plicate receipts
